Our profession

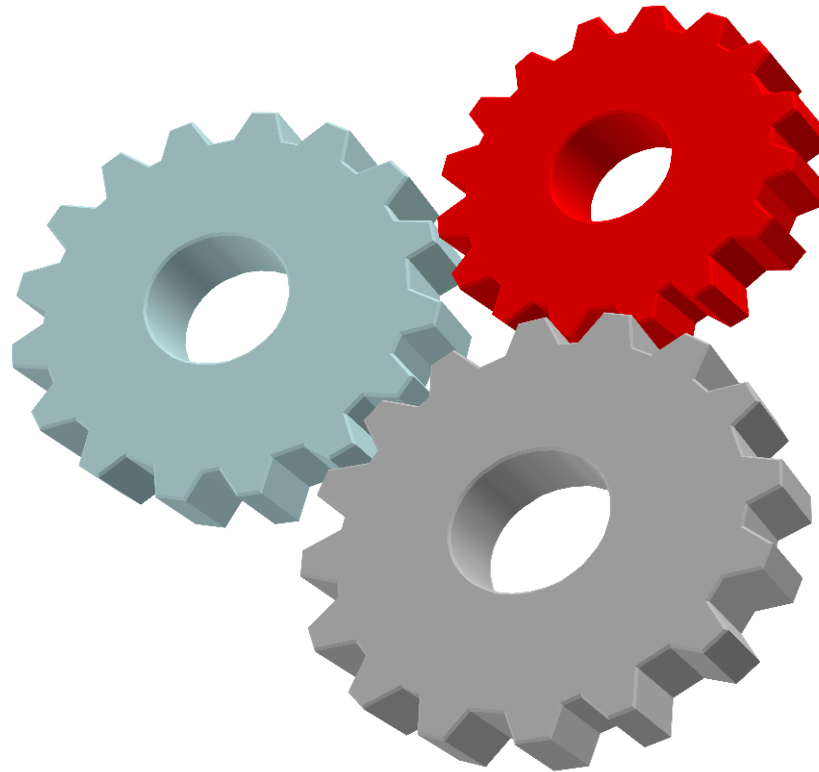


- Among the most mobile qualified professions in Europe

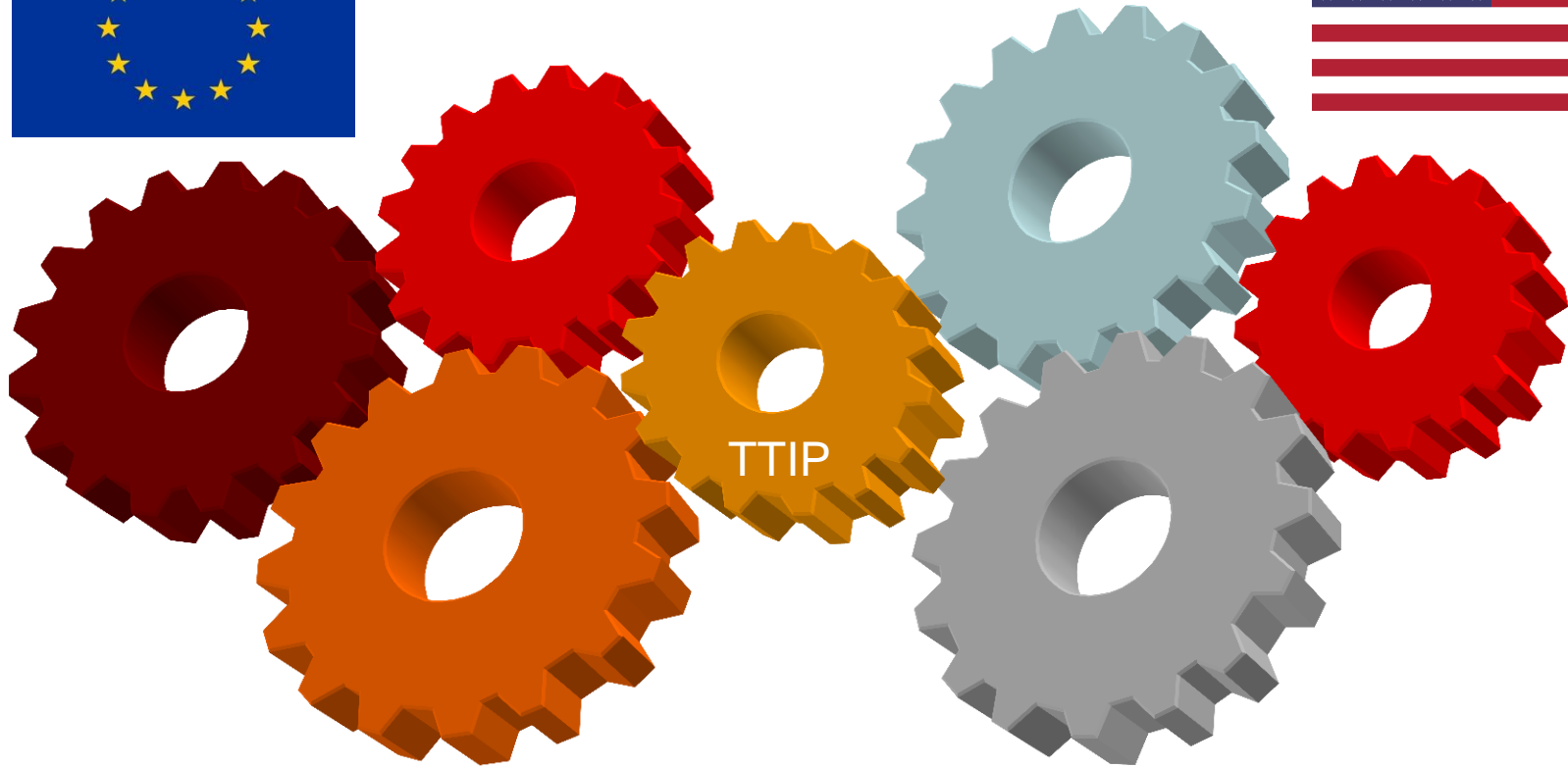
