

## **ECCE ExBo ELECTIONS 2021**

- The Elections will be held during the 73<sup>rd</sup> ECCE General Meeting that will be held in Sofia, on 22-23 October 2021.
- The **President** for the period **2021 2024** will be **Mr. Andreas Brandner** (current Vice President / President Elect).
- The Elections for the New ExBo Members are focused on **six (6) persons** to be elected. The New ExBo (President Andreas Brandner, + six (6) Elected Members + General Secretary = Eight (8) Members) will emerge and will be validated as New ExBo 2021 2024.
- Candidates applying for election to the Executive Board shall:
  - o Submit their names with their personal profile and manifesto
  - Be proposed and seconded in writing by two (2) Member Organizations other than their own one
  - o Have the written approval of their ECCE Member Organization
  - Be engineers (preferably civil engineers)
  - Be National Delegates at the 73<sup>rd</sup> ECCE General Meeting.
- Candidates are eligible to submit their application provided all the annual financial contributions of their national member organization are paid, till that moment (new members) or for the last 3 years, since its last registration as member.
- The candidates' applications including all the previously mentioned data must be submitted to the ECCE Secretariat e-mail address: <a href="mailto:ecce.sps@otenet.gr">ecce.sps@otenet.gr</a> not later than 2
  October 2021 (21 days before the elections). Late applications may be approved / rejected by the ExBo.
- The voting national delegate must be an engineer (preferably a civil engineer) and shall be in writing addressed to the President and sent to the Registered Office by the member organization.
- Every member shall have **one vote**, which shall be cast provided **all the annual financial** contributions are paid, till that moment (new members) or for the last 3 years, since its last registration as member.
- According to the Article 6 of our Articles of Association the Executive Board (except the Secretary General) shall not have more than one member from the same country.
- The current ECCE ExBo will approve the final valid list of candidates.
- The Elections in Sofia will be supervised by a Committee consisted of three (3) persons: current ECCE President (Aris Chatzidakis) + current Vice President/ President Elect (Andreas Brandner) + one Delegate proposed and accepted by the GA.

- The voting Delegates will put six (6) crosses not less/ not more in the ballots with the list of all candidates. Ballots with more or less than six (6) crosses are automatically rejected as not valid by the Supervisory Committee.
- The Elections in Sofia, on 23 October 2021 will be held in two phases:
  - o First Phase: Election of six (6) New ExBo Members (2021 2024)
  - Second Phase: Election of the New Vice President / President Elect (2021 2024)
- Candidates for the post of Vice President / President Elect could be only amongst the elected persons in the first phase as New ExBo Members. The candidatures for Vice President / President Elect (2021 2024) will be submitted to the Supervisory Committee after the end of the First Phase. The GA all Delegates will vote again for electing the Vice President / President Elect 2021 2024.
- The Vice President / Treasurer will be appointed within the New ExBo Members.

In case the 73<sup>rd</sup> ECCE General Meeting cannot be held as an in-person meeting due to the Covid-19 pandemic the ECCE Executive Board Elections 2021 instructions will be adapted accordingly and disseminated to the ECCE Members in due time.
